Dear Mr. Roth:

The use of Militec-1 has saved the Car 26 Stock Car Racing Team some normally expensive repairs.

In the 1994 season we ran a 1980 Ford Pinto with 2300cc engine at over 8000 RPM consistently and have to date collected four feature wins and nine heat victories. We developed a problem with the cam towers breaking which occurred twice. We tore the motor head down on both breaks and found that the cam had not worn. The cam tower breaks however have been attributed to a missing spacer on the timing pulley.

The amazing fact remains. Neither of the two cams sustained wear or had to be replaced due to friction. The 26 Racing team, mechanics and metal experts have examined the head and said the same. Militec stopped the motor from disintegrating itself at earlier stages. Surfaces engaged did not heat right away as would have been the case without Militec-1. The bearing wear after the 1994 Season was 50% less than what it would have been with just engine oil.

Also in 1994, we lost the radiator twice without any damage from overheating. We had a similar situation already in the 1995 season. This time the fan blade broke and the blade went through the radiator. It dumped coolant on the track and the engine immediately heated up but we were still able to get to the pit. We did a quick radiator repair and had the car ready for the feature race. The radiator was still leaking but Militec-1 kept the engine cool and running.

With the 1995 race season under way the Crew Chief and Mechanic for the Team believe that Militec-1 not only adds to the performance but also greatly enhances the longevity of the motor.
