I am writing to let you know how very pleased I am with the Militec products that we have used on our 1944 steam locomotive.

Operating a 450 ton steam locomotive in the modern area, at speeds of up to 75 m.p.h., we see some of the most extreme operating conditions. Last season while operating in the Chicago area, our steam locomotive developed a hot bearing. After cleaning the bearing, we added Militec to our bearings. Operating with Militec all of our bearing temperatures decreased 25 to 30 degrees.

Our locomotive bearings are running at cooler temperatures and we are using significantly less grease. As a result, we are having to grease our locomotive fewer times allowing us to put those man-hours to use in other areas. Additionally, I appreciate your prompt and courteous customer service, as well as your willingness to customize and find products to suit our extreme needs.
